Weekly Enrichment

During the week, the children participate in scheduled class activities to complement their individual Montessori lessons:

- **Monday – Thursday:** Spanish Class
- **Friday:** Show & Tell

Please remember that your child's item for Show & Tell should be a "real world item" to support our Montessori approach; educational, and not a toy; a handmade craft; a non-fiction book; pictures from a family vacation; something from nature or a family photo that will allow the child to share stories and experiences, helping him/her build confidence and communication.

Remember to **label all clothing** with your child's name to ensure items are returned to the correct owner. They are exploring age-appropriate activities, beginning with Practical Life exercises that help strengthen independence, concentration, coordination, and fine motor skills. We are excited to see all the learning, growth, and independence our children will develop throughout the month!
